In February 2013 Wimborne based endurance runner, Jez Bragg, successfully completed the Te Araroa Trail involving an end-to-end traverse of the whole of New Zealand in just 53 days. Jez's 3,054km journey was largely off road and on foot, traversing through some of New Zealand's finest landscapes, but also included a sea kayak crossing of the notorious Cook Strait between the two islands, a feat which few specialist kayakers have even achieved.

In this special one off talk Jez will tell the story of his epic adventure supported by photo and video footage shot by a professional team who followed him to capture his unique journey.
